To accommodate the student population at Saint-Pascal-Baylon, the CSDM's Council of Commissioners approved the addition of temporary classrooms for the next school year. We will minimize noise and movements on the job site, work will focus on the classrooms exterior during the first week and end with interior fittings. Measures will be taken to ensure a safe and peaceful environment according to the standards established by the CSDM, in partnership with the borough, the City of Montreal, and all labour and construction regulatory agencies.


